Representatives from New Jersey Family Care will be at Clinton School to help applicants fill out forms to enroll for medical insurance for their families.

Who Qualifies for NJ Family Care Health Insurance?

- Children up to age 18
- Parents and caretakers of children up to age 18
 - Who are living in NJ
 - Who are citizens or qualified immigrants, including immigrants lawfully admitted for permanent residence
 - Who meet income requirements of the program

What should you bring to apply for NJ Family Care Health Insurance?

Please bring the following for *each* adult and child to be covered:

1. Copy of birth certificate or passport } or we will make copies for you
2. Copy of social security card
3. Proof of residence status (proof of state residency or green card)
4. Proof of address (statement or bill mailed to you)
5. Proof of income
 - pay stub, or W-2, or letter from employer stating annual income
 - if on SSI or any supplemental income, proof of that amount
