### **When/how do you collect pledges?**

Contact friends, family, and neighbors and ask if they would like to help you earn money for your school. Sponsors can play a flat amount or they can pledge an amount for each 15-minute segment (there will be 3 15-minute segments). **DO NOT COLLECT PLEDGES door to door.** Have your pledge sheet (attached) completed before LocoMania takes place on May 21<sup>st</sup>.

### **When are pledges due?**

After LocoMania contact your sponsors and let them know how much they owe you. Send your pledge form and your sponsors' payments to the Clinton PTA by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Do you have to collect pledges to participate?**

**NO.** Even though LocoMania is a fundraising activity, it is also a positive way to promote physical fitness. Every student will participate and 5 students will be chosen at random in early June to receive a pedometer.

### **What will the money be used for?**

The funds raised from LocoMania will be used to purchase a much-needed sound system for our gymnasium. This will allow Mr. Lehman and Ms. Freede to integrate music into physical education classes and also for the PTA to have access to this system for After School Enrichment and other events. The system will include portable microphones for easy communication in a setting which has such poor acoustics.

**Important Note:** We will also take our annual Rainbow photograph on May 21<sup>st</sup>, so please dress your child/children in the color specified for their grade level: Grade 5 (and Gordon & Accurso) – wear red, Grade 4 – wear orange, Grade 3 – wear yellow, Grade 2 – wear green, Grade 1 – wear blue, Kindergarten – wear purple
