# schedule

## Registration **6:00-7:00 pm**

Check in and get your auction program. Your bidding number is written on the back of the program. Use this number for your live auction and silent auction bidding. Tables are set up throughout the room for you to purchase yellow and red tickets for Tricky Tray prizes. One sheet of yellow tickets is included with the entrance fee.

## Door prize raffles (**throughout evening**)

You will receive a door prize ticket upon entering. Door prizes will be announced throughout the evening.

## Yellow prize raffles **6:00-8:00 pm**

One sheet of yellow tickets is included with the entrance fee. Additional sheets of 20 tickets are available for \$5. Yellow prize winners will be announced before silent and live auction prizes.

## Red prize raffles **6:00-8:00 pm**

Raffle tickets for red prizes are \$2 each, or 6 for \$10. Red prize winners will be announced before silent and live auction prizes.

## 50/50 **6:00-9:00 pm**

50/50 tickets will be sold throughout the evening. The winner of this prize, which is half the cash that is collected for the raffle, will be announced (and receive their money) toward the end of the evening.

## Silent auction (**throughout evening**)

Silent auction prizes are on the tables at the perimeter of the room. They are divided into categories. Each prize has a corresponding bid board. If you'd like to bid on a prize, write your paddle number, initials, and bid on the bid board and check back regularly to see if you've been outbid. Be mindful of the minimum bid listed on the bid board, and the minimum increase amount. Categories will be closed on a staggered schedule throughout the evening. Winner's paddle numbers will be announced, and winners can collect their prizes and make payments at the end of the evening at the check-out tables near the front entrance.

## Live auction (**throughout evening**)

Live auction prizes or certificates representing those prizes will be on display at the live auction area. When the live auction begins, raise your paddle (program) to bid. Winners can collect prizes and make payments at the end of the evening at the check-out tables near the front entrance.



# how it works

The Tricky Tray and Auction includes **Yellow Prizes, Red Prizes, Silent Auction Prizes** and **Live Auction Prizes**.

**Door Prizes:** You will receive a door prize ticket upon entering. Drop half of ticket in designated container. Keep the other half with your ticket number. Door prizes will be announced throughout the evening.

**Yellow Prizes:** Upon entering the Woman's Club, you will receive 20 tickets for Yellow Prizes. For \$5, you may purchase an additional 20 Yellow Prize tickets. Each of the Yellow Prizes is numbered and displayed with a clearly marked and numbered corresponding ticket bag. Each sheet has two parts. Put tickets in prize bags and keep the numbered stub for yourself. Prizes will be announced by ticket numbers and your stub contains your number.

**Red Prizes:** Tickets must be purchased. Red Prize tickets cost \$2 each or \$10 for 6 tickets. Red Prizes are numbered and displayed in the same way as Yellow Prizes. See above.

**Silent Auction Prizes:** There are several prize categories. Each prize is numbered and has a corresponding bid board. To bid, write down your paddle number (which appears on the back of your program), your initials, and the amount you wish to bid. Be mindful of the minimum bid required as well as the increments by which you must increase bidding. Check the bid board periodically to be sure you have not been outbid. The highest bidder wins the item. Our emcee will let you know when the various categories of silent auction prizes are closing throughout the evening. The emcee will announce winners by paddle number as the categories close. Winners will go to check-out tables at the end of evening to collect silent auction prizes and make payment. Tell our volunteers your paddle number and they will tally up the total.

**Live Auction Prizes:** Our emcee will announce each item in the live category and indicate the opening bid. To bid for the item, raise your program with your paddle number showing (paddle numbers are on the back of the program). Continue raising your paddle number every time you want to increase your bid. Prize goes to highest bidder.

**Dinner Parties:** For the first time in the history of the Clinton Tricky Tray, our live auction will feature seats at sumptuous dinner parties hosted by Clinton parents. It works like this: During the live auction, our emcee will announce each dinner party separately, the date it will take place, the number of seats available, and the opening bid per seat. If you're interested in buying a seat, raise your program with your paddle number showing (it's on the back of the program). Example: Chinese dinner, 8 seats, \$20 per seat. Maybe 30 people show their paddle number. At that point, the emcee will raise the bid per seat to \$25. This time, only 15 people may show their paddle number. He will keep raising the bid until only 8 people are still interested. Those 8 people each will win a seat. (If you're interested in bidding for two seats, hold up two fingers.)

**How to claim your prizes:** Red and yellow prizes will be distributed as winners are announced. For silent and live auction prizes, which will be announced by paddle number, winners will visit the check-out table at end of evening to make payment and retrieve prizes. **Only cash and checks are accepted.**
